Hugh's view of the Oscars

HE WAS the man of the moment at last year's Academy Awards, hosting the Oscars telecast seen by more than a billion people worldwide, but this year **Hugh Jackman** will be celebrating Hollywood's night of nights in a much more subdued fashion. The *Wolverine* star — who is tipped to star in the 20th Century Fox comedy *Avon Man* (to be penned by *Hitch* writer Kevin Bisch) as a man who reluctantly becomes one of Avon's top salesmen — told me his low-key Oscar plans for this weekend involve watching the awards on television, just like all the rest of us. But he better not get too comfy in his jim jams: the 41-year-old, who picked up a gong for Favourite Action Star at the People's Choice Awards in LA two months ago, is gearing up for *Wolverine 2*, following on from the \$360 million global box office success of the original instalment

of the Marvel Comics classic. IN a major coup for Queensland, internationally renowned fashion designer **Karen Walker** will fly in to Brisbane to present the keynote closing address at the inaugural Creative3 event, a national creative industries-specific forum hosted by QUT Creative Enterprise Australia at Kelvin Grove on April 15-16. She will join other prominent speakers, including Oscar-winning filmmaker **Adam Elliot**, *The Gruen Transfer's* **Russel Howcroft** and Wotif.com founder **Graeme Wood** for the forum, which will feature a blend of keynote presentations, business development workshops and investment pitch sessions for creative industry businesses, with an opportunity to win a \$100,000 prize.
